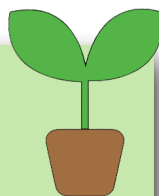

- Woody Vines & Ground Covers

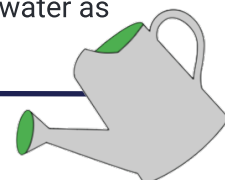
## Garden Maintenance



- Inventory and order seeds
- Make or buy potting soil
- Clean or buy new seedling containers
- Build or buy cold frames
- Clean & repair garden tools
- Turn compost
- Add Mulch to bare spots

## WATER

- Keep perennial herbs fairly dry
- Check seedlings daily
- Water cool crops 1-2 times per week or as needed
- Check annual flowers (pansies, violas, snap dragons, etc.) and water as needed



## CARE

- Fertilize cool crops (leafy greens, broccoli, cabbage, etc.) every 4 - 6 weeks
- Check cool season crops for pests and treat as needed

## Harvest & In-Season Vegetables

- Beets
- Broccoli
- Cabbage
- Carrots
- Celery
