START SEEDS INSIDE

Vegetables/Fruits

- Eggplant
- Kale
- Lettuce
- Mustards
- Peppers
- Spinach
- Tomato
- Tomatillo

Herbs

- Catnip
- Chives
- Cilantro
- Lavender
- Lemon balm
- Lemon grass
- Mint
- Nasturtium
- Oregano
- Parsley
- Thyme

START SEEDS OUTSIDE

Vegetables

- Beets
- Cabbage
- Carrots
- Cauliflower
- Kale
- Kohlrabi
- Mustard
- Radish
- Snow Peas
- Spinach
- Turnips

Herbs

- Parsley

GARDEN MAINTENANCE

- Prune fruit trees
- When frost is in the forecast, cover seedlings and transplants with row covers or close cold frame
- Transplant seedlings to larger pots as needed "Pot up"

WATER

- Water roots deeply before a freeze
- Water cool crops as needed
- Check seedlings daily

CARE

- Check cool season crops for pests and treat as needed
- Pull weeds

HARVEST

- Beets
- Broccoli
- Cabbage
- Carrots
- Celery
- Spinach

TRANSPLANT


Vegetables/Fruits

- Asparagus crowns (3yrs until harvest)
- Onion sets (bulbs)
- Potatoes
- Strawberries, bare root
