GARDEN MAINTENANCE

- Add compost to beds
- Have cold frames or row covers handy to cover new seedlings and transplants when frost is forecasted
- Transplant seedlings to larger pots if needed
- Hill up potatoes
- Thin garden seedlings

WATER

- Check seedlings daily
- Maintain moderate moisture for herbs and cool-season vegetables

CARE

- Fertilize seedlings as directed by product or seed packet
- Check cool season crops for pests and treat as needed
- Pull weeds
